HOW IS MONKEYPOX VIRUS CLASSIFIED?

Monkeypox is classified in **two distinct clades**:


- West African clade is managed as routine Clinical Waste (UN 3291)
- Congo basin clade is managed as
 Category A Infectious Substance (UN 2814)

HOW IT SPREADS


Monkeypox can spread through close contact including sexual contact with someone who has the virus. For example:
